

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Award is given to an individual who has given continuous, sustained support of the library profession through his/her life.

Nominees must be or have been a KLA member for at least 10 years.

Nominees must have a sustained record of service to the Association.

Nominees must have contributed significantly to librarianship (through publications, presentations, and participation in professional library/information organizations).

Nominees must not be current Executive Board member of the Association.

The Award does not have to be presented every year.

The Award, which will consist of a plaque from the Association, will be presented at the Awards Program during the Annual Conference.

Nominations will be solicited by the Library Awareness Committee.

A nominee will be recommended to the KLA Executive Committee for final approval prior to the Board meeting before the Annual Conference.
